



## Changes to the Georgia Health Advantage (HMO I-SNP) 2023 Evidence of Coverage

### **This is important information on changes in your Georgia Health Advantage H8093-001 coverage.**

We previously sent you the Evidence of Coverage (EOC) which provides information about your coverage as an enrollee in our plan. This notice is to let you know there were errors in your EOC. Chapter 4 Medical Benefits Chart, Medicare Part B prescription drugs: Page 58 - 59	In-Network:  You pay 20% of the cost for Medicare covered Part B Drugs.	Beginning April 1, 2023:  In-Network: From 0% up to 20% of the cost for Medicare covered Part B Drugs.	In 2023, your coinsurance may decrease for certain Medicare covered Part B drugs.
Chapter 4 Medical Benefits Chart, Medicare Part B prescription drugs: Page 58 - 59	In-Network  You pay 20% of the cost for Medicare covered Part B Drugs.	In-Network  Beginning July 1, 2023, you won't pay more than \$35 for a one-month supply of each insulin product covered by our plan, no matter what cost-sharing tier it's on, even if you haven't paid your deductible.	In 2023, you will most likely pay less money for your monthly insulin supply, compared to 2022.
